MATHS

Year 4 – Continuing with decimals, money and time.

SCIENCE

Our science topic this half term is Forces. In years 5 and 6 we will be looking at gravity and the work of Isaac Newton, exploring air resistance, friction and mechanisms. In year 4, we will be studying contact and non-contact forces, exploring the properties and uses of magnets

PSHEe
