
Driving With Care: Driving safely when dropping off and picking up from school should always be a priority. Please also drive slowly if you need to use the front school car park. As this car park is a priority for staff at school and Chipmonks, we ask if you limit use of this facility if you can. It has been noted that some families arrive early and wait in their cars, so our staff team are struggling to find a space. Please do NOT
