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Autumn

History

We will be exploring what childhood was like in the past and how it has changed over time. We will be sequencing events on a timeline, interviewing a grandparent and asking lots of questions to find out more!

Phonics

Phonics is taught daily – please look out for sounds and words to practice at home. Additional information can be found in the 'Phonics Newsletter' & your child's Homework book.

Reception

Reception will be participating in learning activities themed by the following books:

The Little Glow Snail and the Whale How to Catch a Star

English

We will be writing a Bonfire Night inspired poem and studying the stories 'Snail and the Whale' and 'How to Catch a Star'! We will focus on using rich vocabulary, text structure and layout.

Alongside these writing units, we will also be writing our 'News' and practicing our skills in other areas of the curriculum. Please keep a look out for activities that can be done at home!

PSHE

We will be exploring our feelings and how to recognise these in other people. Later in the term, we will be learning about what it means to keep something private, including parts of our bodies.

RE

Our unit for this term will focus on exploring the question: Why does Christmas matter to Christians? We will need to use our acting skills to retell the Nativity story!

Maths

Reception children will
continue with our learning of
numbers to 10. Year 1 children
will be learning about Addition
and Subtraction including
Problem Solving. Please look out
for the Maths homework which
encourages your child
to develop Mathematical fluency.

Science

This half term we will be learning about the weather. From measuring the amount of rainfall to the direction of the wind- we will be very busy Scientists!

PF

We will be learning abouthe different elements of Health and Fitness! Please ensure that PE kits are in school every day.

Reading practise books will come home at the end of the week. The aim if for your child to be able to read their book fluently and independently. Please celebrate your child's success at home by hearing him/her read and by encouraging the use of expression everyday.
