Robins and Wrens

(Nursery, Reception & Year One)

Children will now enter and leave school via the top gate (through the car park)

The gates will open at 8.45.

Staff will be waiting to greet children and parents at the conservatory door.

From here, children will enter the classroom independently to hang their coats and begin their day.

At the end of the day, the gates will open at approximately 3.25pm. Parents are welcome to wait on the yard from this time.

Children will be dismissed by the class teacher or TA via the conservatory doors.

Starlings and Owls

(Year Two, Three, Four, Five and Six)

Children will now enter and leave school via the main playground gates (the usual ones)

The gates will open at 8.45

Staff will be waiting to greet parents and children on the path leading up to the entrance (or under the cover if it's raining!!)

Please accompany children around the corner so that they are handed over to staff safely.

At the end of the day, the gates will open at approximately 3.25pm. Parents are welcome to wait on the yard from this time.

Children will be dismissed by the class teacher or TA from these sides. Starlings will be dismissed from the left and Owls from the right.
