### **Phonics**

Phonics is taught daily – please look out for sounds and words to practice at home. Additional information can be found on the Little Wandle website. Y1 children will bring home some additional activities as we approach the Phonics Screening test in June.

#### Ar

In Art, we will be experimenting with a range of mark-making techniques, responding appropriately to music. We'll practice colouring neatly and carefully, featuring a range of different media and colours.

#### Maths

Reception children will
continue with our learning of
numbers to 10. Year 1 children
will be learning about
Multiplication and Division
including Problem Solving. Please
look out
for the Maths homework which
encourages your child
to develop Mathematical fluency.

## Reception

Reception children will be continuing their learning journey thinking about London, Transport, Spring and Earth Day to name but a few!

## History

We will be learning about famous explorers this half term and the amazing things they discovered. We will be focusing upon Christopher Columbus in particular!

### Music

We will be learning about folk songs from North America, recognising their features including high and low sounds and inventing new verses. We will sing songs whilst performing a song and play a two-note accompaniment, playing the beat, on tuned or untuned percussion.

## **English**

We will be focusing on the narrative unit 'The Queen's Hat' and writing 'All Aboard the London Bus' We will focus on using rich vocabulary, text structure and layout. Alongside these writing units, we will also be writing our 'News' and practicing our skills in other areas of the curriculum. Please keep a look out for activities that can be done at home.

#### RE

We will be learning about the story of Creation this half term and all the different things Christians believe God created in seven days!

#### Science

We will be exploring the properties of different materials.
We will be carrying out experiments to test the strength of a material and its absorbency.
