

We are very much looking forward to this event as we always have such a super day (staff are also welcome to dress up too!)

Save the date: Year 6 Crucial Crew Event: On Friday, 15th March, Year 6 pupils will be attending the Crucial Crew Event at Eston Grange. Pupils will need to bring a packed lunch on the day (if your child is in receipt of Free School Meal funding, we will provide this, if you prefer to provide your own packed lunch, please let the school office know in advance). Crucial Crew is a multi-agency event organised through schools, by the police and supported by the fire service. They aim to raise awareness of safety issues to school children in Year 6 (aged 10-11).

A letter will follow nearer the time to cover the event in more detail. Transport will be provided by Bibbys of Ingleton.
