ENGLISH

We will be developing our writing skills through the following text:

Balanced Argument – Screen Use

We will also develop our understanding of grammar, spelling and punctuation and practise our handwriting skills. In addition, we will use 'VIPERS' questions to help us with reading comprehension.

SCIENCE

Our science topic this half term is Animals and Humans. We will be looking at the role of the heart in the circulatory system, the digestive system and differences in the teeth of carnivores and herbivores.

HOMEWORK
