Happy New Year! We hope that you had a magical Christmas and a well-earned rest! This half term is set to be a busy one with lots of exciting things happening in class. Please find below the details of this half term's focus. Alongside this, we will also be developing the children's own interests and ideas. There will be lots of outdoor exploration so please send hats, gloves and a warm coat.

Art

In Art, we will be learning about different techniques such as cutting, threading, curling paper and joining techniques. We'll be making some tissue flowers and applying our skills to make create some master pieces.

Geography

We're going to find out about the weather in the UK. To do this, we will be learning to name and locate the 4 countries of the UK, identifying the country we live in, using a compass and studying the seasons!

Maths

In Maths, Y1 will be learning about Place Value and Addition and Subtraction of Numbers to 20. Reception will be thinking about 1 more and 1 less, subitising and the composition of numbers. We will also be problem solving and applying our skills practically.

Computing

We are going to continue practising our mouse and keyboard skills. We will be using a range of programmes to develop our understanding. We will also be logging in and out of our own computers!

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be thinking about economic Wellbeing. This will involve learning about coins and notation, banks, earning money and the difference between 'want' and 'need'

Science Seasonal Changes

We are going to be learning about the 4 seasons, which months fall in each season, investigating and measuring rainfall,

English

In English, we will continue to think about the use of punctuation including full stops, capital letter and ? We will be looking at some Non-Fiction texts about Sharks and Penguins and will write our own reports

RE

In RE, we will be learning about Christianity. Focusing particularly on bible teachings and thinking about why the bible is important to Christians.

PE

In PE, we will be doing Dance and Gymnastics. We will be exploring and engaging music to create our own routines and will master movements such as rolling, jumping and landing
