Art

We will be exploring sculpture and 3D art this term. We will be rolling, shaping and constructing imaginative sculptures using paper before applying painting skills to our 3D models.



Our learning will focus on finding out about the seaside. We will locate and name the seas around the UK, learn what the coast is and identify the physical features of them. We will also think about how people use the local coast.



In Maths, Y1 will be learning about multiplication and division, fractions, position and direction, place value, money and time. Reception will be comparing and counting on from different numbers as well finding out about the composition of numbers. For example, 7 is 5 and a bit more,



We will be learning about how to stay safe online this half term. We will discuss what the internet is and how it can be used. We will also think about how the internet may affect our emotions and how use of it can affect others.



In PSHE, we will be thinking about keeping ourselves safe. We will learn about road safety, consider hazards at home and identify which substances should or should not go in our bodies.



Science

Our topic for this term is 'Everyday Materials'. We will identify and name a variety of materials and describe their properties. We will also find out about natural and manmade materials and investigate which materials float and which sink.



English

In English, we will focus on using punctuation correctly and spelling tricky words accurately. We will be reading 'Chocolate Mug Cake' and use it to help us write instructions. We will also read 'The Bear and the Piano'.



In RE, we will be learning about sacred places and what makes some places sacred to some people. We will be learning about what is inside a church and a mosque and how the objects and spaces are used.
