Homework

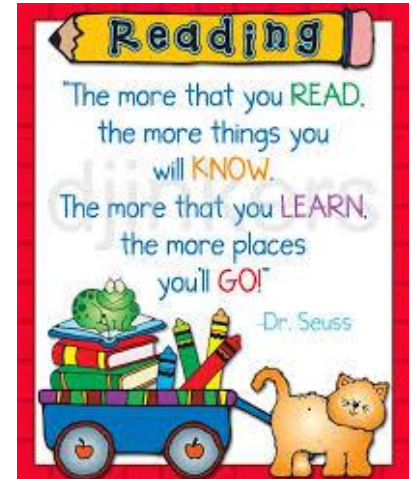
