PE will be taught every **Tuesday** and **Thursday**. Please send your child to school in their PE with a spare pair of shoes. If the weather remains pleasant, we will go outside!

Please remember children should wear shorts/joggers/leggings with a plain white t-shirt and trainers. Please can you send your child with the appropriate hair accessories to tie their hair up to keep it out of their eyes whilst taking part in PE. Children with pierced ears should remove their earrings for PE sessions. If the ears are newly pierced, please tape over the earrings. Lastly, we would ask that if your child wears trainers to school as part of their uniform, they should be plain black with no other colour visible.
