Reading Books

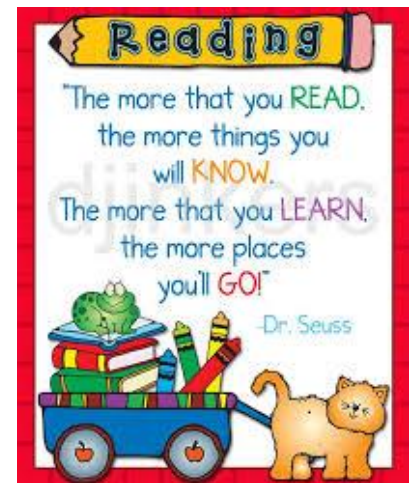
