History

In History, we will be learning about 'How am I making history?' We will be thinking about the past, present and future events in our lives.

Autumn Two

Phonics

Phonics is taught daily – please look out for sounds and words to practice at home. Additional information can be found in your child's Homework book which will be sent home each Friday.

Reception

Reception will be participating in learning activities themed by the following books: Little Glow Snail and the Whale How to Catch a Star

English

We will begin by writing a poem based on 'Firework Night'. We will then be focusing on the narrative units 'Snail on the Whale' and 'How to Catch a Star'. We will focus on using rich vocabulary, text structure and layout. At the end of each unit we will be writing our narrative during our 'Independent Write' sessions. Alongside these writing units, we will also be writing our 'News' and practicing our skills in other areas of the curriculum. Please keep a look out for activities that can be done at home!

PSHE

We will continue learning about relationships, looking at safe relationships and how to look after ourselves and others.

Design Technology

For our unit this term we will be looking at windmills and naming the different parts. We will then follow instructions to make our own windmills using a variety of materials.

Maths

Reception: We are going to be focusing on the composition of numbers 1-5. We will also find and name circles, triangles, squares and rectangles.

Year 1: This term, we will continue working on Subtraction and Shape. Please continue to practice counting, looking for patterns and identifying shapes at home.

Science

This term we will be observing and learning about the changing of the seasons from Autumn to Winter. We will be looking at the weather and measuring rainfall.

R

Our unit for this term will focus on exploring the question: Why does Christmas matter to Christians?

P

This half term, we will be learning about health-related fitness.
