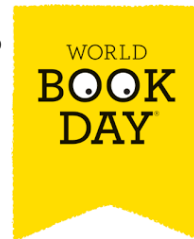
Forensic Science Day: Last month we held a Science Day across our three schools with the children becoming amateur CSI investigators. They were each given the scenario of trying to find out who had committed the dastardly crime of breaking Mrs Maddock's favourite stapler! The children were split into their Houses so the year groups worked together, examining a footprint, fingerprints and other vital clues left by the culprit.

World Book Day: World Book Day is just a few weeks away (**Thursday, 6th March**) and as usual pupils are welcome to come to school dressed as their favourite character from a book of their choice or in their pyjamas (additional layers may be needed if coming in pyjamas) and appropriate footwear please. Attendance: Law changes which came into effect from 19th August 2024 mean that the cost of Penalty Notices has increased. Penalty charges are now £160 if paid within 28 days, reducing to £80 if paid within 21 days per parent/carer per child.

The **National Framework for Penalty Notices** introduces a **new national limit of two** penalty notices that can now be issued to a parent for the same child within a rolling three-year period. If a second Fixed Penalty Notice is issued to the same parent for the same child, within three years of the first Fixed Penalty Notice, the second Fixed Penalty Notice is charged at a flat rate of £160 if paid within 28 days.

Once two Fixed Penalty Notices have been issued, if a third unauthorised leave of absence occurs within a three-year period, the Local Authority is able to move to prosecution immediately.

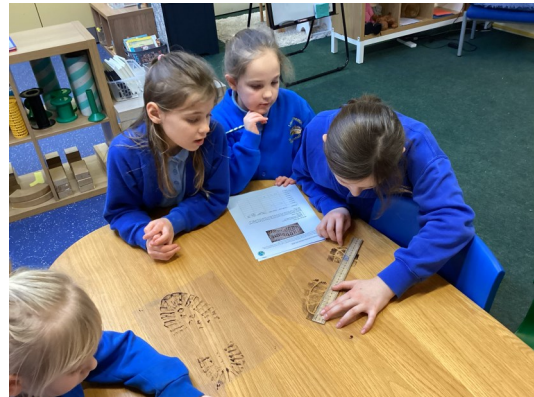
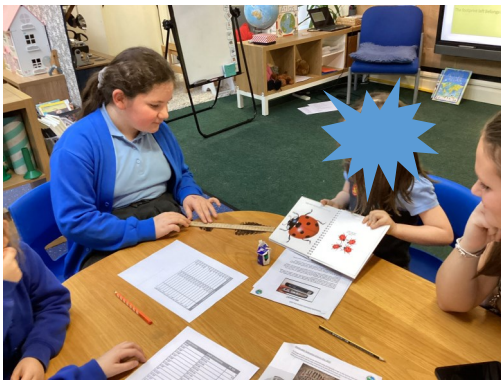
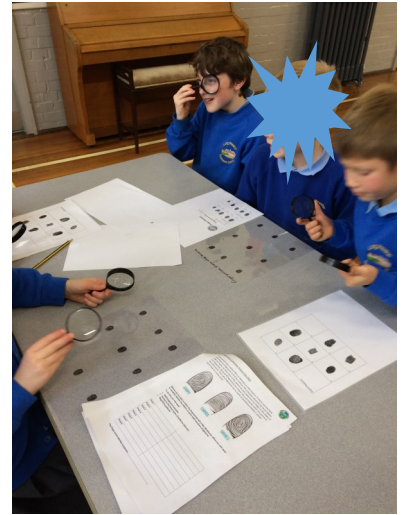
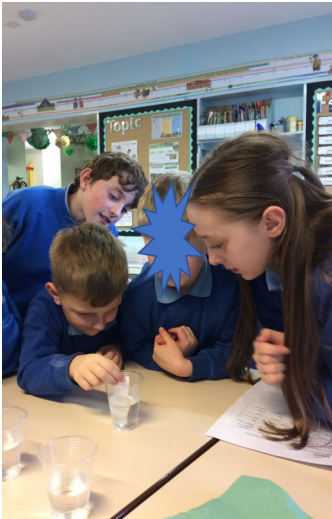
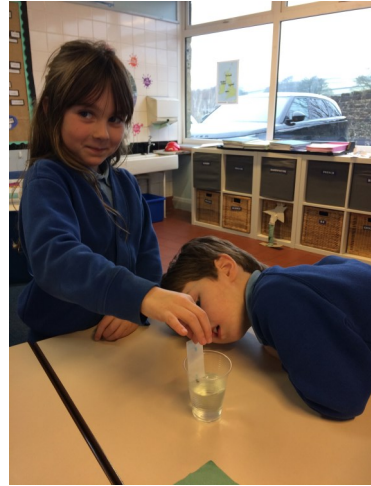
